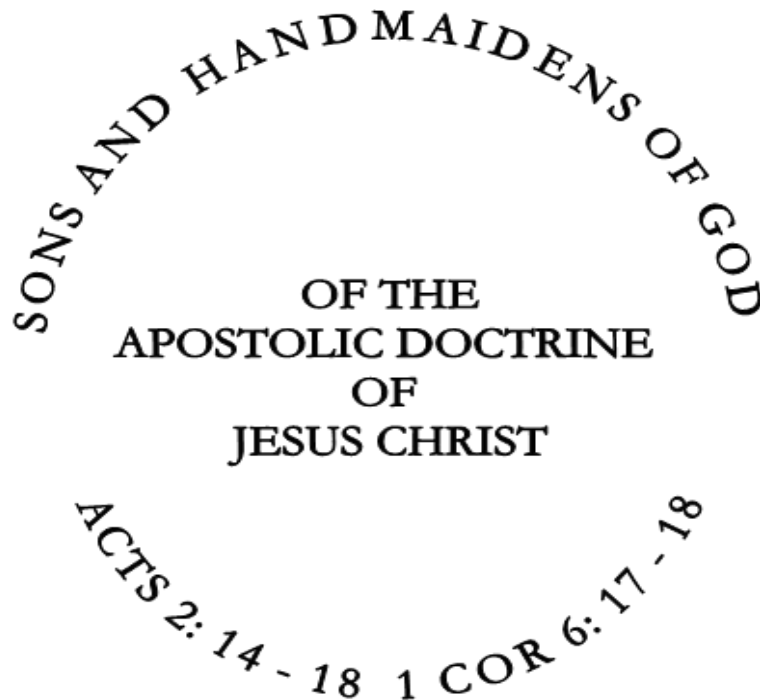

SUBJECT: Jesus' Blood Paid for Our Sins

Praise the Lord Saints and friends. We greet you in the mighty and glorious name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace (Isaiah 9:6). We honor the Bishops, Prophets, Prophetesses, Pastors, Mothers, Elders, Evangelists, Teachers, Ministers, Deacons, Saints, and Friends. Jesus' blood paid for our sins and all men everywhere should reverence Him because of his redeeming power. Jesus made us free. If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed (John 8:36). Men no longer have to be bound by the yoke of bondage. They have a choice to experience liberty through Jesus Christ our great God. Individuals need to be made free from the empty lifestyles they have been taught from their forefathers. While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal (II Corinthians 4:18). The worldly things are temporal; they do not last, and they are not eternal. God's spirit is living within our hearts and giving us that assurance of living forever with Jesus Christ. And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and will give them a heart of flesh (Ezekiel 11:19). Do not focus on the world, its pleasures and possessions; these things are vain. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world (I John 2:16). These things cause the heart to be empty, void, unfulfilled, and incomplete. Men, women, boys, and girls everywhere need to be made free and delivered from the empty life that they have been taught and are accustomed to living. A worldly life does not work. It leaves mankind empty, void and doomed to death, an eternity apart from God. Solomon said it is all vanity and vexation of the spirit. And he did evil in the sight of the Lord, and walked in the way of his father, and in the way of his mother, and in the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin (I Kings 22:52). He also walked in the ways of the house of Ahab: for his mother was his counsellor to do wickedly (II Chronicles 22:3). We have been freely redeemed: our redemption did not cost anything. Apostle Peter said, Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; 19) But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot; 20) Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you (I Peter 1:18-20). Jesus Christ is our Passover Lamb, without blemish and without spot. He came without sin. He was perfect and sinless. Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus (Romans 3:24). Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: 14) In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins (Colossians 1:13-14). Before the world was created the Lord knew and predestined Christ to redeem man by coming and dying on the cross. Known unto God are all his works from the beginning of the world (Acts 15:18). Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, let every one that nameth the name of

Christ depart from iniquity (II Timothy 2:19). And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day (John 6:40). Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live (John 11:25). Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, 21) Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen (Ephesians 3:20-21). May the Lord Jesus Christ bless you richly.
