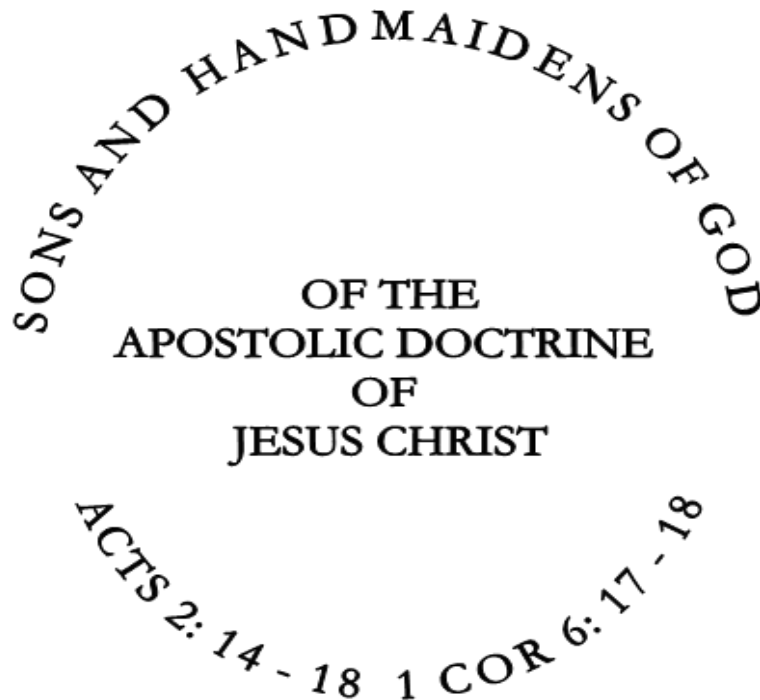

SUBJECT: Let Your Eyes Be Opened to Salvation!

Great honor unto the Precious Name of Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior. We honor all Prophets, Prophetesses, Bishops, Pastors, Mothers, Elders, Evangelists, Teachers, Ministers, Deacons, Saints, and Friends. Our challenge is to believe and to thank God for the word. We are to trust our Savior that what He said does and will come to pass. Faith is demonstrated by actions. John 9:6-7, When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay, 7) And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing. It took faith to hear, see, and believe what he was told to do. The man's example to us is, he having no ability to see, had to envision his eyes being restored. He had to obey the instruction given unto him by Jesus. John 9:11, He answered and said, A man that is called Jesus made clay, and anointed mine eyes, and said unto me, Go to the pool of Siloam, and wash: and I went and washed, and I received sight. We must always be aware of others who do not see, even if they have eyes! What Jesus plans for you is for you. They may ask, but realize he went and washed and received sight. Where is he? This man is not of God, because he keepeth not the sabbath day. Never let the traditions of others keep you from the will of God in your life. I Thessalonians 5:24, Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it. Hebrews 11:6, But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. We acknowledge that what we experienced this past year proves our determination to be persistent and persevere. Being persistent, you are continuing until that which you seek for occurs. Also, individual perseverance in spite of difficulties and obstacles during discouragement, shows they allow the grace to lead them to eternal salvation. Often, we may ask the Lord to increase our faith just as the apostles did. Luke 18:1, And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint. Persist in setting time of communication with Jesus Christ. Ephesians 6:18, Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints. Just as Jesus opened the eyes of the blind, he opens our spiritual eyes. Follow his instructions not being concerned what others may say. Acts 2:36-40, Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made the same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ. 37) Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do? 38) Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. 39) For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the LORD our God shall call. 40) And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation. May the Lord Jesus bless your eyes to be opened and salvation come to pass in your life.
