Habakkuk 2:1-4, I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what he will say unto me, and what I shall answer when I am reprov'd. 2) And the Lord answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. 3) For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry. 4) Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith. Habakkuk 1:5,12, Behold ye among the heathen, and regard, and wonder marvelously: for I will work a work in your days which ye will not believe, though it be told you. 12) Art thou not from everlasting, O Lord my God, mine Holy One? we shall not die. O Lord, thou hast ordained them for judgment; and, O mighty God, thou hast established them for correction. John 3:31-36, He that cometh from above is above all: he that is of the earth is earthly, and speaketh of the earth: he that cometh from heaven is above all. 32) And what he hath seen and heard, that he testifieth; and no man receiveth his testimony. 33) He that hath received his testimony hath set to his seal that God is true. 34) For he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him. 35) The Father loveth the Son, and hath given all things into his hand. 36) He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him. I Peter 3:18, For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit. Galatians 1:4, Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father. Faith is important,

for without faith it is impossible to please Him. We know that faith worketh by love, and that love covers a multitude of sins. I John 4:10, Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. I John 2:2-6, And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world. 3) And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. 4) He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. 5) But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him. 6) He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked. I John 5:1-4, Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him. 2) By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments. 3) For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous. 4) For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith. We are grateful to be partakers of the grace, mercy, and salvation of our Savior Jesus Christ and thank him daily for his love for us. What a vision Habakkuk spoke of. He made it plain; the appointed time is now. We are blessed. It was written, now we can run because we have read it. Praise the Lord Women of the most High God. Pray that our eyes be open to his will, commandments, and purpose.
