Subject: The Things which God Hath prepared for them that Love Him!

We greet you in the Mighty and Excellent name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus, the Christ of God. We honor all Prophetesses, Mothers, Evangelists, Teachers, Sisters, Saints, and Friends. I Corinthians 2:9-10, But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. 10) But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. Saints of the most high we are thankful for this opportunity; for all blessing come from the Lord Jesus Christ. Revelation 22:14, Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city. John 14:1-3, Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. 2) In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3) And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. II Corinthians 5:1-2,7, For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. 2) For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven: 7) For we walk by faith, not by sight. Philippians 3:20-21, For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ: 21) Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself. I John 3:2-3, Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. 3) And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure. Are we troubled? Do we believe? Can we be honest with ourselves? Romans 4:21, And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform. We have faith in Jesus Christ. We understand that we need the Comforter, the Holy Ghost today. Romans 8:11, But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you. II Corinthians 4:11-18, For we which live are always delivered unto death for Jesus' sake, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our mortal flesh. 12) So then death worketh in us, but life in you. 13) We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak;

14) Knowing that he which raised up the Lord Jesus shall raise up us also by Jesus, and shall present us with you. 15) For all things are for your sakes, that the abundant grace might through the thanksgiving of many redound to the glory of God. 16) For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day. 17) For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory; 18) While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal. Titus 2:11-15, For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, 12) Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world; 13) Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ; 14) Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. 15) These things speak, and exhort, and rebuke with all authority. Let no man despise thee. Hebrews 11:1, Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. We also realize that we cannot be made without the blood-bought heaven-redeemed, Spirit filled church. Thank God that faith brings us that are Christians, to a place of peace and contentment, which we need in this time of trouble. We have a choice, either to give into the flesh or to allow the Holy Ghost to reign in our lives. If we walk in the Spirit, we will produce the fruit of the spirit, which pleases God.
