**Subject: Will Jesus Christ Find Faith on Earth?**

We honor our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! We honor all Prophetess, Mothers, Evangelists, Teachers, Sisters, Saints, and Friends. Luke 18:1-8, And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint; 2) Saying, There was in a city a judge, which feared not God, neither regarded man: 3) And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of mine adversary. 4) And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, Though I fear not God, nor regard man; 5) Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me. 6) And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust judge saith. 7) And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them? 8) I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth? In this parable we are reminded that we are to always pray. Psalm 17:1, 6 Hear the right, O Lord, attend unto my cry, give ear unto my prayer, that goeth not out of feigned lips. 6) I have called upon thee, for thou wilt hear me, O God: incline thine ear unto me, and hear my speech. Psalm 102:1-2, Hear my prayer, O Lord, and let my cry come unto thee. 2) Hide not thy face from me in the day when I am in trouble; incline thine ear unto me: in the day when I call answer me speedily. This judge that feared not God nor regarded this widow was faced with a woman who had faith. What if the request or petition were made of one who had great faith, how would Jesus respond? Matthew 15:22-28 And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, thou son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil. 23) But he answered her not a word. And his disciples came and besought him, saying, Send her away; for she crieth after us. 24) But he answered and said, I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel. 25) Then came she and worshipped him, saying, Lord, help me. 26) But he answered and said, It is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast it to dogs. 27) And she said, Truth, Lord: yet, the dogs eat of the crumbs which fall from their masters' table. 28) Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour. Acts 11:17, Forasmuch then as God gave them the like gift as he did unto us, who believed on the Lord Jesus Christ. Many witnessed the love of Christ, whether by answered prayers or great faith. One thing is certain, Christ Jesus responded to the need. The woman with the issue of blood. Matthew 9:22, But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole. Luke 7:44-50, And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine

house, thou gavest me no water for my feet: but she hath washed my feet with tears, and wiped them with the hairs of her head. 45) Thou gavest me no kiss: but this woman since the time I came in hath not ceased to kiss my feet. 46) My head with oil thou didst not anoint: but this woman hath anointed my feet with ointment. 47) Wherefore I say unto thee, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loveth little. 48) And he said unto her, Thy sins are forgiven. 49) And they that sat at meat with him began to say within themselves, Who is this that forgiveth sins also? 50) And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace. Acts 2:37-39, Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do? 38) Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. 39) For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.
